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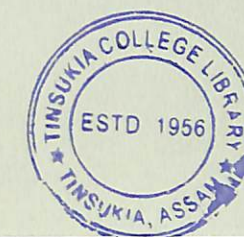




EDITORIAL

NATIONAL SEMINAR

A UGC sponsored two day national seminar on "Realities of Globalization : Exploring Issues Related to Politics, Economy and Culture in India with Special Reference to the North-East Region" was organised jointly by Departments of Economics and Political Science in collaboration with KKHSOU Study Centre, Tinsukia College on 23rd and 24th June, 2016.



Noted political analyst Prof. Abu Nasar Saied Ahmed, a former faculty of IIT Guwahati, delivered the key note address. Prof. Ahmed, while addressing a large gathering of students and researchers, opined that the recent joint statement on nuclear deal by Modi-Obama in Washington, letting a loss-making firm of USA which was rejected by USA itself, to build six nuclear reactors in India was a matter of safety concern. On globalization, he said, it affected most on the traditional culture, food habits and wisdom of North-Eastern people, the hub of various ethnic communities.

A total of 104 research papers were presented in four technical sessions. Earlier on the day, the programme began with inaugural speech by Prof. Surjya Chutia, while Prof. Boikuntha Das welcomed the guests, research scholars and teachers. Dr. Bhuban Gogoi, Principal of the college, initiating the seminar, highlighted some conflicting issues emerging out of globalization. After that Prof. Rasmita Borkakoty offered the vote of thanks.

Chairpersons of the four technical sessions were Prof. Abu Nasar Saied Ahmed, Prof. Gautam Purkayastha, Associate Prof. Margherita College, Dr. Alpana Borgohain and Dr. Deb Kumar Chakraborty, Heads of Political Science and Economics Departments respectively of Dibrugarh University.

ENTREPREURSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

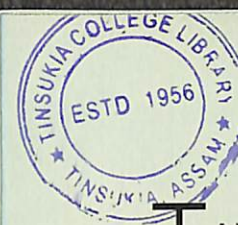

The 5 days programme was sponsored and conducted jointly by the Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Government of India and ICT Academy of Tamil Nadu.

The inaugural function of the 5 days programme was held on 6th January 2016 under the chairmanship of Sri Ratna Gopal Gogoi, the president, NSS unit of the college in presence of Dr. Bhuban Gogoi, the Principal and Dr. Rishi Das, the Vice Principal of the college. Dr. Achyut Borthakur, HOD, History dept. also addressed in the function. In his inaugural speech, Dr Gogoi highlighted the responsibilities of students towards community and laid stress hard on work and commitment.

Sri Surjya Chutia, the Programme Officer of the NSS unit initiated the whole function where Sri Niranjan Shukla, Associate Prof. Commerce dept. of the college delivered the key note address.

A total of 10 technical sessions were held during the 5 days programme. TINSUKIA COLLEGE NSS SPECIAL CAMP



The National Service Scheme (NSS) Tinsukia College Unit regularly undertakes various programmes such as repairing roads, cleaning drives, health & hygiene awareness camps at the neighboring villages to develop the civic sense of responsibility of the students' volunteers. The unit completed a seven days NSS special camp successfully from 24th February to 1st March 2016 at Bokajan Gaon under Lankachi Panchayat, Tinsukia. The Bokajan Gaon has been adopted by the Tinsukia College under the Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) scheme of Indian Government in 2015. A team of 28 students' volunteers (both boys & girls) of the college actively participated the camp under the guidance of Surjya Chutia, the programme officer and Ratna Gopal Gogoi, the president of the NSS unit. The team repaired a village path, campus cleaning programme of the Bokajan L.P. School during the period. The team also planted trees within the school campus for making a green campus. Besides, the team made a door to door survey to know socio-economic and hygienic status of the households of the gaon through a questionnaire prepared for the purpose. The college unit has decided to organise some need based development programmes at the village on the basis of the finding of the survey later on, to make the village an 'ideal village' under SAGY. Teachers of the college Ajit Phukan, Bhadreswar Choudhury, Dr. Rajib Konwar, Dr. Nilim Jyoti Senapati and Tankeswar Das also took part the camp.

The villagers and the teachers of the Bokajan L.P. School fully co-operated the team and expressed their satisfaction over the performance of the NSS Camp. On the last day of the camp the students' volunteers participated the camp were given certificates of participation in a meeting.

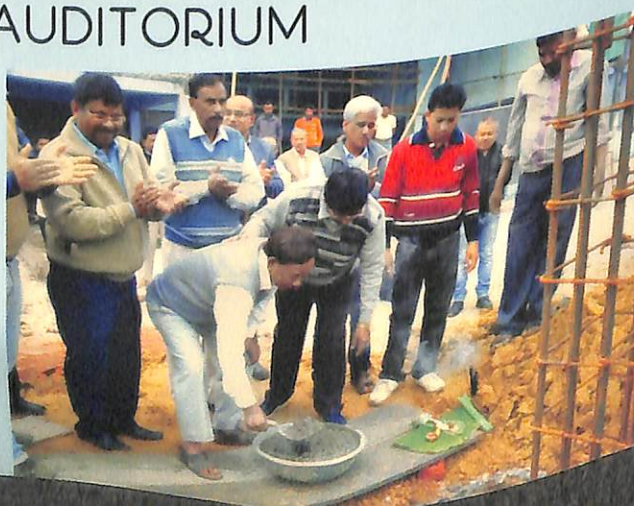
CELEBRATION OF SWAHID DIVAS
