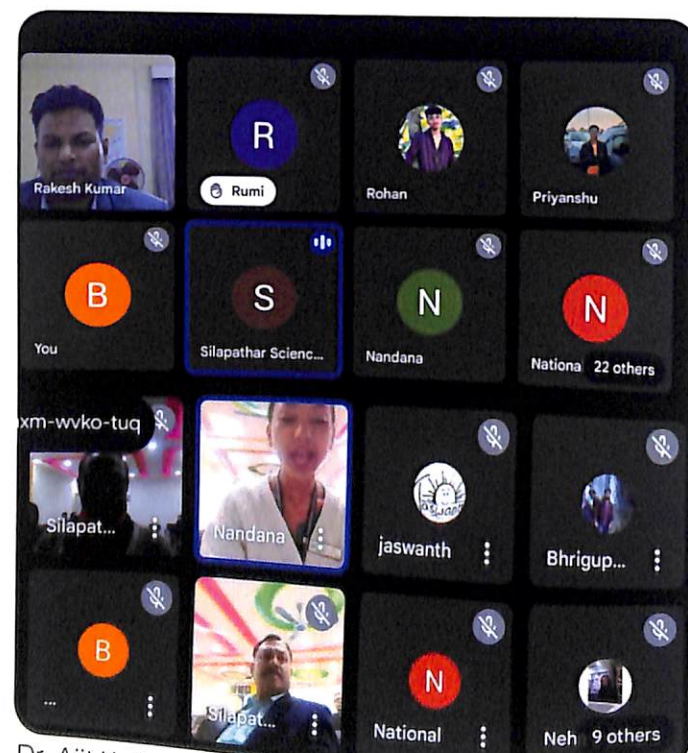

One-day workshop on "Solid Waste Management, Vermi-Composting and Rainwater Harvesting" organised at Tinsukia College

A one-day workshop on "Solid Waste Management, Vermi-Composting, and Rainwater Harvesting" was conducted on 8th February 2025 at Tinsukia College under the Environment Education Programme (EEP), supported by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC), Government of India, and implemented by the Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC), Government of Assam. The event was organized by the Eco Club of Tinsukia College, in collaboration with the Department of Botany and IQAC, Tinsukia College. The workshop aimed to create awareness among students about effective waste

management practices, the conversion of organic waste into compost through vermicomposting, the importance of conserving water by harvesting rainwater, and the need to safeguard the environment while maintaining cleaner and greener surroundings. 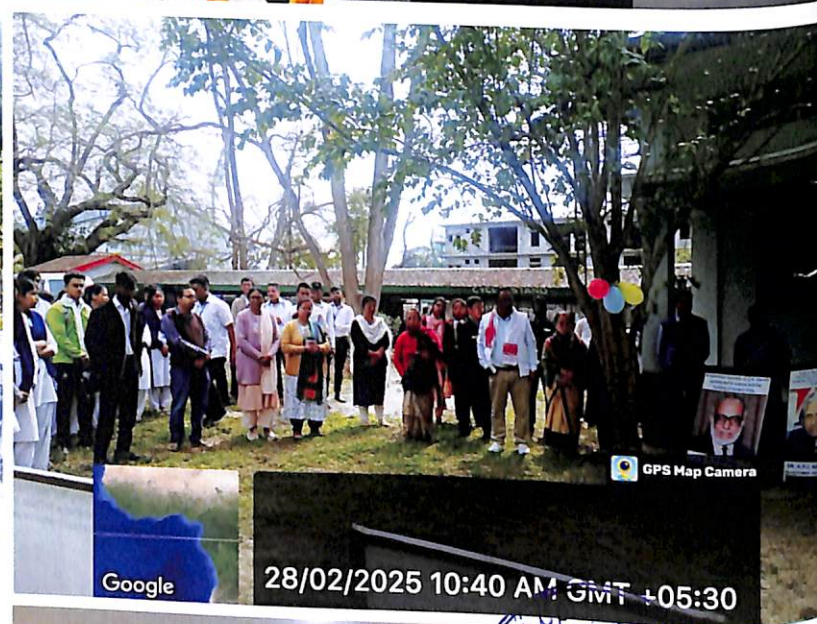
