“Bhaxa Gaurav Xaptah” Observed



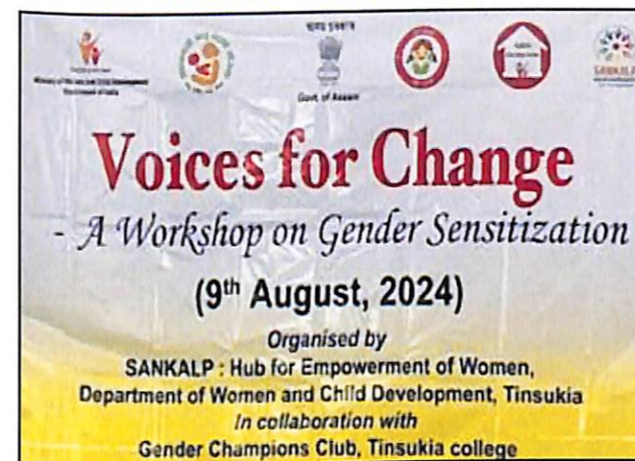

National Librarian's Day Observed

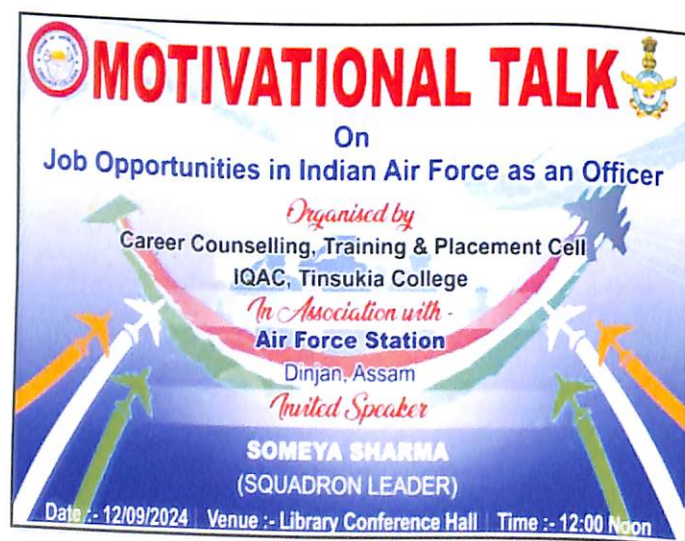

Motivational Talk on "Job Opportunities in the Indian Air Force as an Officer"



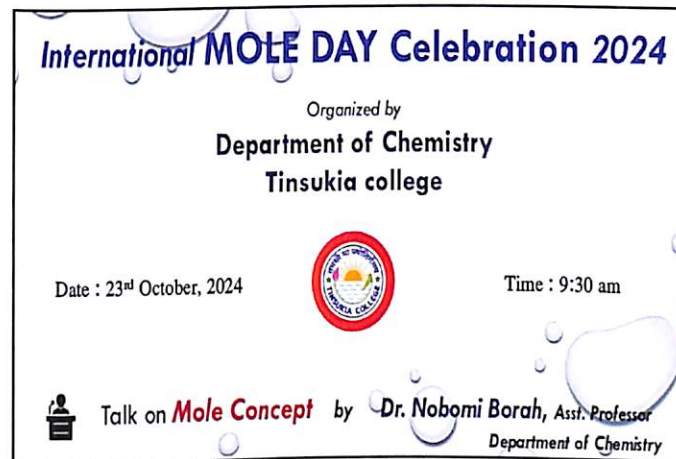

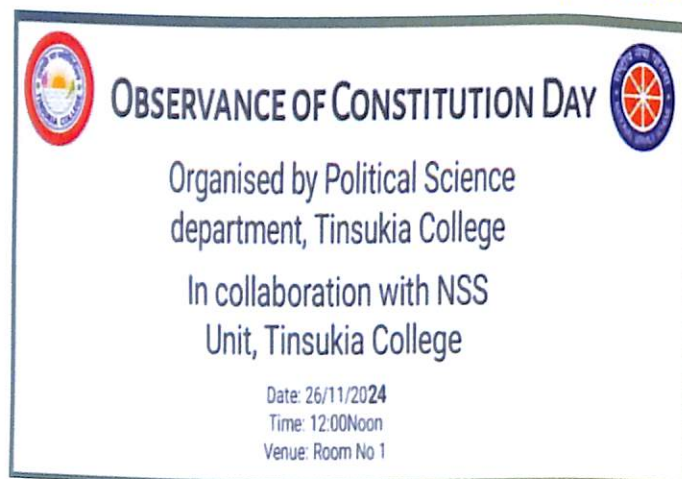
Blood Donation Camp organised in collaboration with HDFC Bank, Tinsukia Branch and Civil Hospital, Tinsukia

National Constitution Day observed by NSS Unit in collaboration with Department of Political Science



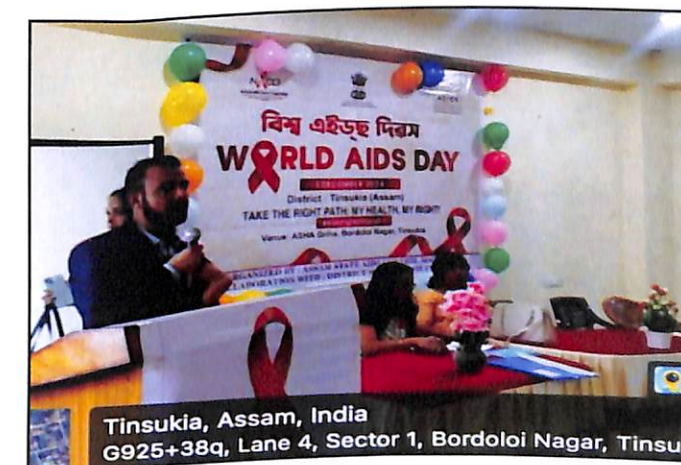
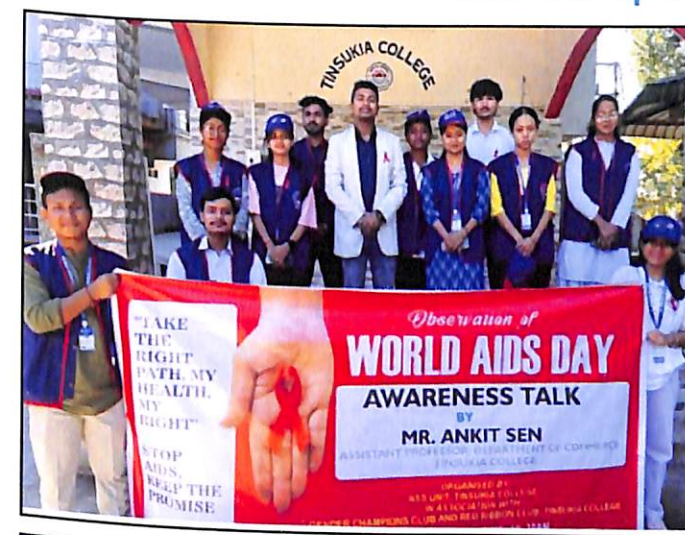
